

9-Person Round Robin Tournament

PLAYERS SIGN UP INDIVIDUALLY AND WILL PLAY A ROTATION WITH OTHER PLAYERS. NOT A TEAM EVENT.

Players: Must be in groups of nine players. Groups of nine may be divided by gender, ability, etc.

Duration: Approximately 3 hours with 2 courts. May be longer depending on the number of players and the number of courts.

Games: All players will play a minimum of 8 games and a maximum of 10 games.

Each nine-person group will play independently with no cross-over (unless playing 18 players in one bracket)

Round Robin Play:

The first play session will have each player playing one game with each other player and each round one person will sit out. This will be a total of nine rounds with each player playing eight games to 11 (win by two).

After all nine rounds, the players are seeded by total wins, then by total point differential, then head-to-head wins, and then head-to-head point differential.

Bracket Play:

The top six players from the round-robin will advance to the bracket. The first and second seed get a bye for the semi-finals. The third seed gets to pick their semi-final partner from the 4,5, and 6 seeds. The winner of the semi-final round advanced to the finals. The first seed gets to pick their finals partner from the winners of the semi-final round (i.e. can't be the #2 seed). The second seed plays with the remaining winner from the semi-finals.

Bracket matches can be single game to 11, single game to 15, or two out of three to 11 (three-hour duration is based on single game to 11).
